Advertising in Bar News

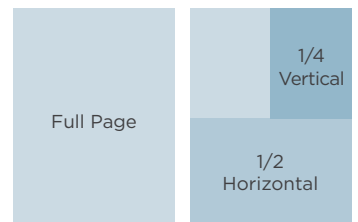

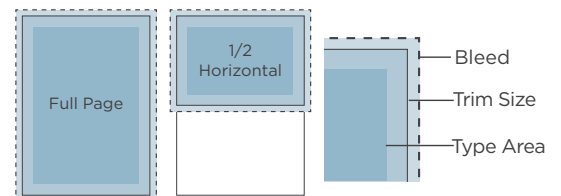

InBrief welcomes advertisements relating to events, recruitment and other items relevant to our members and which support the objectives of the NSW Bar Association.


